Update from the Charitable Law Section--William Donovan shared a summary of the Ohio Cleanwater Fund case connected with the East Palestine train derailment.

Training and Charitable University updates--Beth Short shared that the entire curriculum of Charitable University should be posted on the AGO website any day now. The Attorney General recently adopted a policy requiring that one half of the board members of any group receiving grant funds from the office must complete Charitable University. School districts are adopting similar language.

Other business.

Tom Paulson shared he is seeing an increase in COVID and other contagious illnesses. Funding for security is much needed in a variety of situations in Ohio, including places of worship, Howie Beigelman said.
