## NOTICE OF DISMISSAL

On June 12, 2023, the Attorney General issued an *Amended Notice of Intent* (the "Notice") to Connected Progress to deny its 2023 application for a license to conduct bingo. At no point did Connected Progress request a hearing on the Notice.

Connected Progress withdrew its 2023 Charitable Bingo License Application via email through its President, Joshua Bett, on July 7, 2023.

There being no charitable bingo license application before the Attorney General for Connected Progress, the Attorney General hereby dismisses the Notice in this case. However, the Attorney General reserves all rights to take necessary action against any subsequent charitable bingo license application based on unresolved, alleged violations of law as described in the Notice.
