



SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

This SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT is made by and between Gameco, Inc., located at 12319 Plaza Drive, Parma, Ohio 44130, and the Attorney General of Ohio (Attorney General), for the purpose of resolving issues regarding Gameco, Inc.'s bingo distributor license. Together, the Attorney General and Gameco, Inc. are referred to hereinafter as "the Parties."

1. The Attorney General is responsible for the administration of charitable bingo licensure and enforcement of charitable bingo laws under Ohio Revised Code Section 2915 (ORC), and Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) Rule 109:1.
2. The Attorney General has authority to revoke an application for a Bingo Distributor License. The Office also may suspend, place limitations, restrictions or probationary conditions on that license for a limited or indefinite period.
3. An applicant for a license or endorsement under Chapter 2915. of the Revised Code and this chapter shall, at all times, have the burden of demonstrating to the attorney general, by clear and convincing evidence, that the applicant is eligible, qualified, and suitable to be granted and retain the license or endorsement for which application is made under the applicable standards and requirements of Chapter 2915. of the Revised Code and this chapter.
4. Gameco, Inc. is a licensed Bingo Distributor, (D-0004) during all relevant periods contained in this Settlement Agreement. Gameco, Inc.'s distributor license is set to expire August 29, 2026.
5. Bob Sossa is a key employee and sales associate for Gameco, Inc. as reported to the Attorney General.
6. Bob Sossa posted/reposted bingo advertisements on the Facebook page "Bingo Lovers in Cleveland" for St. Sava Servian Eastern Orthodox Church (St. Sava) on October 28, 2025, Teen Start Program on June 26, 2025, and Altered Church on November 26, 2025.
7. Gameco, Inc., violated ORC 2915.07(A) by employee, Bob Sossa, advertising bingo for three charitable organizations licensed in accordance with ORC 2915.08.
8. Bob Sossa currently volunteers for St. Clement of Ohrid Macedonian Orthodox Church (St. Clement) as a bingo caller.
9. Bob Sossa's bingo conduct for St. Clement qualifies him as a "bingo game operator" as defined in ORC 2915.01(Q).

10. Gameco, Inc. violated ORC 2915.018E(4), ORC 2915.07(A), and OAC 109:1-4-02(G) by their employee, Bob Sossa, conducting bingo on behalf of a charitable organization licensed in accordance with ORC 2915.08.
11. St. Sava, St. Clement, Altered Church and Teen Start Program are currently licensed by the Ohio Attorney General to conduct Type I charitable bingo.
12. ORC 2915.081(D) states “(t)he attorney general shall not issue a distributor license to any person that is involved in the conduct of bingo on behalf of a charitable organization.”

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises herein expressed, and with intent to be legally bound, the Parties agree as follows:

- A. Gameco, Inc., shall pay the Attorney General \$2,500 (two thousand five hundred dollars and zero cents), for each violation stated in this SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT, totaling a Civil Penalty Amount of \$5,000 (five thousand dollars and zero cents).
- B. The Civil Penalty shall be paid by check, cashier’s check, or money order, or wire transfer (for wire transfer please contact CharitableFundsAccounting@OhioAGO.gov), payable to “Treasurer of the State of Ohio” as Custodian for the Ohio Attorney General and mailed to:

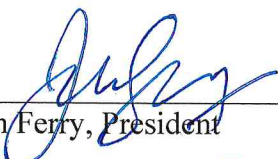
Civil Penalty amounts shall be deposited in accordance with R.C. 109.112 into the AGO Court Order and Settlement Fund for transfer, upon the Attorney General’s request, to the Charitable Law Fund established under R.C. 109.32;

- C. This SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT prohibits any employee of Gameco, Inc., from volunteering for any bingo related activity, or receiving any form of compensation, tip, wage, donation or benefit by any charitable organization licensed under ORC 2915.
- D. Gameco, Inc., shall remove Bob Sossa as their sales representative for St. Clement upon the execution of this SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT.
- E. Gameco, Inc., agrees to comply with the requirements of ORC Chapter 2915, and any OAC rules adopted thereunder.
- F. This SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT is a limit, restriction, or probationary condition on Gameco, Inc., Bingo Distributor License No. D-0004 issued pursuant to ORC 2915.081.

- G. Upon execution of this SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT the Attorney General will not seek a suspension of Gameco, Inc., Bingo Distributor License due to the violations referenced in paragraphs 6-10;
- H. Gameco, Inc., agrees that if it fails to comply with the terms of this SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT, it may be subject to revocation, suspension, denial, additional limitations or restrictions, and probationary terms under ORC Chapter 2915.
- I. This SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT is binding upon the Parties, and any and all successors, assigns, subsidiaries, agents, employees, or representatives of the Parties or any other affiliates. Any breach of this SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT by Gameco, Inc., will discharge the Attorney General from any obligations under the terms of this SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT, but will not discharge Gameco, Inc., from any obligation it has under this SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT.
- J. By signing this SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT, the Attorney General is not waiving any rights he has to conduct further investigations of Gameco, Inc., and to initiate an action against Gameco, Inc., for further violations of ORC Chapter 2915 or any Ohio Administrative Code rules adopted thereunder.
- K. This SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT may be modified in writing by the Parties. Modifications are at the sole discretion of the Attorney General.
- L. The Parties have read and understand this SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT and have entered into the same knowingly, voluntarily, and with the opportunity to gain advice of counsel.
- M. This SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT supersedes any and all prior agreements between the Parties.
- N. This SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT is entered into by both Parties and may be executed in counterparts or facsimiles, each of which shall be deemed an original, but all of which shall constitute one and the same instrument. It shall be considered binding and effective upon the date of the last signature of all requisite Parties and individuals.

The Parties to this SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT have either executed it or caused it to be executed by their duly authorized representatives as evidenced by the signatures below:

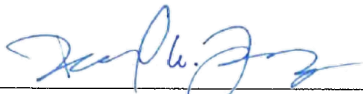
