

List of Disqualifying Offenses for Professional Solicitors

Individuals who have been convicted of the criminal offenses listed below are disqualified from registering as a professional solicitor with the Ohio Attorney General's Office.

However, a disqualification may be overcome if the individual applying for the registration or, as applicable, by the individual's employee, holds a certificate of qualification for employment issued under section 2953.25 of the Ohio Revised Code (O.R.C.) or a certificate of achievement and employability issued under section 2961.22 of the Revised Code.
